



2023 Scholarship Application

The Atlantic Federal Credit Union Foundation is pleased to offer a scholarship program to members who are high school seniors in Androscoggin, Cumberland, Sagadahoc or York County. A \$10,000, \$5,000, \$2,500, \$1,500 and \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to graduating senior students. Scholarship recipients will be chosen through a review process by the Atlantic Scholarship Committee.

All applicants must complete the following requirements to be considered for the \$10,000, \$5,000, \$2,500, \$1,500 or \$1,000 scholarships:

1. The student applying for a scholarship **MUST BE** a primary account member (primary account member is defined as the actual owner of an account) with an open account at Atlantic Federal Credit Union.
2. The student must be or will be enrolled in an undergraduate program at a chosen college or vocational school that requires a tuition – minimum of 6 credit hours per semester for fall 2023.
3. **Please submit all the below documents together as *one package*** (Adobe PDF or Microsoft Word Documents only):
 - a. A completed application.
 - b. Write a 350-400 word essay (**Essay Question: If you wrote a letter to yourself to be opened in 20 years, what would it say?**)
 - c. Provide a resume, including community involvement, extra-curricular activities, and ways in which you have demonstrated leadership.
 - d. Provide high school transcript (most recent version).
 - e. Provide reference letter from a teacher, counselor, mentor or employer that speaks to your work experience, skills, expertise, personal qualities, and/or academic performance.
 - We understand that it may not be possible to include your reference letter in this package. If that's the case, your reference can mail/email it directly to us. However, if all items have not been received or postmarked by March 24, 2023, you will not be eligible for the scholarship.

Complete document package (Adobe PDF or Microsoft Word Documents only) can be submitted by mail/email and must be received or postmarked no later than March 24, 2023.

All recipients will be notified by mid-June at the latest. Scholarship recipients will be **awarded after the completion of their fall semesters** in which the **student must maintain a 2.0 GPA** (grade point average) **or higher to be eligible**. Student must be registered for 2024 spring classes. Scholarship recipients are responsible for submitting a request for payment and provide Atlantic with all documentation (grades, class schedule, school billing address, school tax id number and student id number) required prior to award payment. **Scholarship recipients that do not fulfill all the requirements prior to April 1, 2024, will no longer be eligible for the scholarship award.**
