2019 Scholarship Application

Atlantic Federal Credit Union is pleased to offer a scholarship program to members who are high school seniors. A \$7,500, \$2,500, \$1,000 and eight \$500 scholarships will be awarded to graduating senior students. Scholarship recipients will be chosen through a review process by the Atlantic Scholarship Committee.

All applicants must complete the following requirements to be considered for the \$7,500, \$2,500, \$1,000 and \$500 scholarships:

1. The student applying for a scholarship **MUST BE** a primary account member (primary account member is defined as the actual owner of an account) with an open account at Atlantic Federal Credit Union.
2. The student must be or will be enrolled in an undergraduate program at a chosen college or vocational school – minimum of 6 credit hours per semester for fall 2019.
3. **Please submit all of the below documents together as one package:**
 - a. A filled out application.
 - b. Write a 350-400 word essay (*Essay Question*): ***If you were given the ability to change one moment in your life, what moment would you change and why?***
 - c. Provide a resume, including community service.
 - d. Provide high school transcript (most recent version).
 - e. Provide reference letter from high school teacher or counselor.
 - *We understand that it may not be possible to include your reference letter in this package. If that's the case, your teacher/counselor can mail/email it directly to us. However, if all items have not been received or postmarked by April 7, 2019, you will not be eligible for the scholarship.*

Complete document package can be submitted in person, or by mail/email and must be received or postmarked no later than April 7, 2019.

*All recipients will be notified by the end of May at the latest. Scholarship recipients will be **awarded after the completion of their fall semesters** in which the student must maintain a **2.0 GPA** (grade point average) or higher to be eligible. Student must register for 2019 spring classes. Scholarship recipients are responsible for submitting a request for payment and provide Atlantic with all documentation (grades and class schedule) required prior to award payment. **Students that do not comply with all the requirements prior to April 1, 2020, will forfeit the scholarship award.***
